

Re: Prop 65



Dear Customer:

Rotor Clip regularly receives inquiries as to its compliance with the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 commonly known as "Prop 65". In response we offer the following statement.

Among its many products, Rotor Clip currently offers retaining rings and hose clamps with Chromium (hexavalent compounds) coating (identified by the following part number suffixes-ZF,-ZD, -G, -R) and cadmium coating (military only, identified by the following part number suffixes -MCD, -CD). Both of these substances are present on the list of "Chemicals known to the State [of California] to Cause Cancer or Reproductive Toxicity" which underlies Prop 65's labeling requirements.

In order to comply with Prop 65, Rotor Clip has adopted the following labeling language for effected parts:



WARNING: This product can expose you to chemicals including cadmium and cadmium compounds which are known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov.
